

## **“I Share my Space” Video Contest**

### **Official Rules**

#### **1. ELIGIBILITY:**

The “I Share My Space” Contest (“Contest”) is open only to legal residents of any one of the 50 United States or the District of Columbia who are 18 years of age or older at time of entry. Employees, directors and officers of LiquidSpace, Inc. (“Sponsor”), its contractors and agencies involved in the administration, development, fulfillment and execution of this Contest, and the immediate family members of each and those living in the same households of each such person, are not eligible to participate.

#### **2. CONTEST PERIOD:**

You may enter the Contest between 12:00:01 am Pacific Time (“PT”) on January 27, 2012 and 11:59:59 pm PT on March 1, 2012 (“Contest Period”).

#### **3. TO ENTER:**

To enter the Contest, go to <http://www.austinguc.com> (“Web Site”) during the Contest Period. Follow the on-screen instructions to properly complete and submit a registration form for the Contest. When prompted, you will be asked to provide a link to your original video (each a “Submission”) to the Web Site. Before uploading the Submission, you will be required to agree that you have (a) read and agree to these Official Rules, and (b) received permission for the use of the image/likeness of all identifiable persons appearing in your Submission. You may use your own release form to confirm permissions from persons appearing in your Submission; however, if you are selected as the winner of the Contest, you will be required to obtain a release provided by Sponsor signed by each identifiable person appearing in your Submission. Submissions that do not include all required information and adhere to the Official Rules as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion will be considered void.

The person completing the Contest Registration and linking to the Submission will be deemed the entrant (“Entrant”). If any group elects to collaborate on a Submission, they are required to designate one (1) person as the representative of the group to enter the Contest, agree to these rules and accept the prize on behalf of the group. Sponsor is not liable for any disputes between collaborators arising under or related to the Contest. Each individual Entrant may make only one Submission to the Contest.

#### **Requirements For Video Submission:**

- a) Your Submission must be about coworking and answer one of three questions: (a) What is coworking?; (b) Why do you love coworking?; or (c) What is your favorite coworking story?.
- b) Your Submission must be no longer than 30 seconds.
- c) If you are selected as a winner, you may be asked to provide a higher resolution version or the original audio and video files used during production of the Submission.

- d) Must be the original work of the Entrant produced for this Contest --it may not have been entered in or won previous contests or awards.
- e) May not include any material owned by third parties including without limitation any third party trademarks or copyrighted or copyrightable materials
- f) Must be primarily in the English language.
- g) Must otherwise be consistent with these Official Rules.

Submissions must comply with all applicable law. Submissions must not infringe any party's intellectual property or other rights or invade privacy, publicity or other rights of any person, entity or group. Submissions must not contain: nudity or profanity; obscene, indecent or pornographic material; defamatory statements (including but not limited to words or symbols that are widely considered offensive to individuals of a certain race, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation or socioeconomic group); or threats to any person, place, entity or group.

Submissions that do not comply in all material respects with the Terms of Services or these Official Rules or that otherwise contain prohibited or inappropriate content as determined by the Sponsor, in its sole discretion, will be disqualified.

By entering this Contest and uploading your Submission, you irrevocably grant to Sponsor and its agents and sublicensees the unconditional and perpetual right to post, display, publish, broadcast, use, adapt, excerpt, edit and/or modify such Submission in any way, in any and all media, for promotional or any other purpose, without limitation, and without consideration to you. All Entrants further agree to release and indemnify and hold harmless Sponsor from all claims that any use of a Submission subsequently produced, presented, and/or prepared by or on behalf of Sponsor infringes on the rights of Entrant's work as contained in any Submission. Winner hereby waives in favor of Sponsor all rights of "Droit Moral" or "Moral Rights of Authors" or any similar rights or principles of law that Winner may now or later have to his/her Submission.

#### 4. SELECTION OF WINNER:

The winner of the Contest (the "Winner") will be selected by a panel of judges ("Judges") on or about March 8th, 2012, at the GCUC (Global Coworking UnConference) in Austin, Texas. Each eligible Submission will be judged based on originality, creativity and relevance to the coworking theme.

Winner will be notified by email. If attempted notification is returned as undeliverable, if Winner does not respond within 10 days after first attempt, or if Winner is otherwise unable to accept prize, prize will be forfeited and will be awarded to an alternate Winner.

#### 5. PRIZE:

The prize totals to US\$2,000: US\$1,000 will be given to the Winner and US\$1,000 will be given to the charity of Winner's choice. The charity must be a bona fide charity and is subject to approval by Sponsor in its sole discretion. Prize is non-transferrable.

Winner is solely responsible for any taxes on their respective prizes, and will receive an IRS Form 1099-MISC for the taxable value of the prize.

## 6. AFFIDAVITS AND RELEASES:

Winner will be required to complete, sign and return an Affidavit of Eligibility/Liability Release, and, where lawful, a Publicity Release. Each person whose image, likeness and/or voice appears in the winning Submission must agree that he/she will execute a release in the form required by Sponsor and may be required to enter into a standard acting guild agreement.

## 7. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

By completing a registration form and submitting a Submission, each Entrant agrees to be legally bound by these Official Rules.

Sponsor has the sole right to decide all matters and disputes arising from this Contest. All decisions of Sponsor are final and binding in all respects. Winner, by acceptance of the prize, agrees to release, indemnify and hold harmless Sponsor and any parent or affiliated companies, and each of their employees, officers, directors, agents and representatives from all liability, loss, damage, cost or claim related to any allegation regarding participation in the Contest or the acceptance or use of the prize.

In the event of any inconsistency between these Official Rules and the Terms of Service of the Web Site, the terms in these Official Rules shall prevail.

If for any reason the Contest is not capable of running as planned, including without limitation, infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other causes which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the Contest, Sponsor reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, modify or terminate the Contest. Further, Sponsor reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual deemed to be (a) tampering or attempting to tamper with the entry process or the operation of the Contest or Web Site; (b) violating the Official Rules; (c) violating the Web Site terms of service; or (d) acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other person. This Contest is offered only in the United States and is governed by the laws of the state of Texas, USA.

No liability or responsibility is assumed by Sponsor resulting from any user's participation in or attempt to enter or participate in the Contest or ability or inability to upload or download any information in connection with participating in the Contest. No responsibility or liability is assumed by Sponsor for technical problems or technical malfunction arising in connection with any of the following occurrences which may affect the operation of the Contest: hardware or software errors; faulty computer, telephone, cable, satellite, network, electronic, wireless or Internet connectivity or other online communication problems; errors or limitations of any Internet service providers, servers, hosts or providers; garbled, jumbled or faulty data transmissions; failure of any e-mail transmissions to be sent or received; lost, late, delayed or intercepted e-mail transmissions; inaccessibility of the Web Site in whole or in part for any reason; traffic congestion on the Internet or the Web Site; unauthorized human or non-human intervention of the operation of the Contest, including without limitation, unauthorized tampering, hacking, theft, virus, bugs, worms; or destruction of any aspect of the Contest, or loss,

miscount, misdirection, inaccessibility or unavailability of an email account used in connection with the Contest.
